#### God Assures Us of Forgiveness

Call to Confession

Ex. 20

Prayer of Confession

*(Forms & Prayers)*

**Our Father, we are sinful and You are holy. We recognize that we have heard in Your law difficult words, knowing how often we have offended You in thought, word, and deed, not only by obvious violations, but by failing to conform to its perfect commands, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. Apart from Christ, there is nothing in us that gives us reason for hope; for where we thought we were well, we are sick in the soul. Where we thought we were holy, we are in truth unholy and ungrateful. Our hearts are filled with the love of the world; our minds are dark and are assailed by doubts; our wills are too often given to selfishness and our bodies to laziness and unrighteousness. By sinning against our neighbors we have also sinned against You, in whose image they were created.**

Our Father, although You are a holy God, who cannot look upon sin, look upon Christ our Savior and forgive us for His sake. You have promised us that if we confess our sins, You are faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. For if we do sin, we have an Advocate before Your throne, Jesus Christ the Righteous, and He is the propitiation for our sins. Give us Your pardon by Your mercies, dear Father, for You have clothed us in the righteousness of Christ. We ask also that You would give us an increase of the grace of Your Holy Spirit, so that we may learn the wisdom of Your ways, and walk in Your holy paths, for Your glory and the good of our neighbor.
